NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. Significant Accounting Policies

A. The financial statements are prepared and presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in India and the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. The Company follows the accrual method of accounting under historical cost convention.

- B. Fixed Assets are stated at costs less depreciation. The Company capitalises all cost relating to acquisition and installation of Fixed Assets.
- C. Depreciation on Fixed Assets is calculated at the rates specified in Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 on straight-line basis. As Trade Mark registration is valid for 10 Years, Trade Mark value is being amortised over a peiod of 10 years, leaving 5 % Residual Value. However development of Surite Software App has been decided by the management to be amortised over a period of 10 years from the year of effective implementation for commercial usage.
- D. Alongwith direct cost related to software development, all Indirect costs viz establishment expenses, professional fees etc. are attributable to Sofware Application till the completion of the App for Commercial use, which was done on 31st March'2021, have been capitalised.
- E. Short term employees benefits (i.e. benefits payable within one year) are recognized in the year in which employees services are rendered.
- F. Provision for Income Tax are based on assessable profits computed in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act 1961. Deferred tax is recognized, subject to the consideration of prudence, on timing difference, being the difference between the taxable income and accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods.
- 1.2 Preliminary expenses will be amortised over a period of time, subject to maximum of 5 years commencing from the year of operations.
